Please let me share with you what the Lord has called me to do this summer.

Child Evangelism Fellowship® of Wyoming has accepted me to train and serve with Christian Youth In Action® as a <u>volunteer</u> summer missionary.

I will participate in two weeks of missionary training in June. After training, I will be working with other missionaries teaching children in 5-Day Clubs[®], serving in Fair ministries, and counseling children at Camp Good News[®]. I will be sharing the Gospel, teaching dynamic evangelistic Bible lessons, life-changing Scripture memory verses, Gospel songs, and inspiring real-life missionary stories.

The cost of the training camp and my teaching materials is \$335. I am asking if you would prayerfully consider donating to CEF of Wyoming to help defer this cost for me.
